YOUNG VOLUNTEER REPRESENTATIVE - ROLE SUMMARY TO REPRESENT YOUNG MEMBERS (U25) IN THE LONDON & SOUTH EAST REGION ON THE REGIONAL MANAGEMENT BOARD (RMB)

Please note, as this is a young representative role, all applicants must be under 25 years of age themselves at the time of nomination. For U16s, a parent/guardian/other responsible adult will be required to chaperone the applicant to all RMB meetings (usually held at the House of Sport in London Bridge) and working group meetings. For U18s, a signed declaration from a parent/guardian/other responsible adult will be required to confirm the applicant has permission to travel unaccompanied.

Key Tasks:

- Listen to the concerns, suggestions and feedback of young people and collate their feedback to help improve their netball experience within the region.
- Attend RMB meetings, contributing from a young person's perspective.
- Champion the importance of developing young leaders.
- Chair and support the co-ordination of a youth working group.
- Provide support for County colleagues where required.
- Work alongside Regional staff and other working groups to promote opportunities and competitions for young people
- To help build stronger links between the Region and the young people in the community.
- Voting member on the RMB.

Desirable knowledge & skills:

- Confident and approachable.
- Enthusiastic with a good knowledge of netball and netball structure in the Region.
- Strong communication skills both written and verbal.
- Strong IT and social media knowledge and capabilities.
- A good listener with the ability to gain feedback and convey information at Board level.
- Good organisation and planning skills.
- Behave impartially at all times.
- Take an interest in and respect the viewpoints of others.
