

## **Young Volunteer Representative - Role Summary**

**To represent young members (U25) in the London & South East region**

***Please note, as this is a young representative role, all applicants must be under 25 years of age themselves at the time of nomination. For U16s, a parent/guardian/other responsible adult will be required to chaperone the applicant to in-person RMB meetings (usually held near London Bridge) and working group meetings. For U18s, a signed declaration from a parent/guardian/other responsible adult will be required to confirm the applicant has permission to travel unaccompanied.***

The London & South East Regional Netball Association is one of nine member organisations of England Netball who, working closely with England Netball staff, help develop and facilitate the delivery of all aspects of netball within the region. Each region has an elected Regional Management Board of volunteers who manage a wide variety of netball activity on a local level; from coaching and officiating, to equality, diversity & inclusion and competitions.
