Who will the Senior Head Coach work with?

- Club member players
- Parents/guardians
- Club coaches/assistant coaches
- Managers for each team
- Club committee

What will the Head Coach do?

- Produce a club wide development plan for all coaches, players and teams to meet the club objectives
- Provide structured training sessions to the Senior squads on a weekly basis
- Select players for all Senior squad matches
- Attend matches and tournaments
- Provide player support and feedback in regard to each individual player's development

How much time will the Senior Head Coach need to give?

- At least 3 hours coaching a week, held every Wednesday at Redbridge Sports Centre
- Up to 2 hours a week administration and preparation
- Attend County, Regional and National matches (usually every Saturday)

What qualification and experience does the Senior Head Coach need?

- Minimum England Netball Level 2 Coaching qualification
- At least 5 years experience of coaching Senior Players (14 and above)

What are the benefits and how will the club support the Senior Head Coach?

- Developing players and coaches within the club
- The club will pay for coaching time and reimburse all agreed expenses that are incurred in carrying out the role
