Couch to Court


England Netball have announced their new <u>Couch To Court</u> campaign, introduced to get more than 4,000 women playing netball or more netball in the New Year. The concept has been introduced to help battle inactivity amongst women and to encourage even more people to step on a netball court in 2020, meaning more people can enjoy the social and physical benefits the sport has to offer.



The campaign enables anybody to simply sign up to the initiative here and after doing so they will be provided with guidance and support via email to help them overcome any nerves and feel prepared to get on a court near them. The Couch To Court web pages also provide details of all netball clubs and approved netball sessions across the country, many of which will be tailored perfectly for beginners who haven't played for a very long time, making it really easy to find something local in January. As an added incentive, we will enter anyone who takes part in an England Netball session or who becomes an England Netball member, which means joining an England Netball registered club between 17th December and 19th January, into a prize draw for the chance to win some exciting money can't buy prizes.

The Regional Coordinator (RCO) is the key point of contact for regional enquiries and distributing information to Members. They support the County Committees, Regional Management Board and England Netball Regional Staff. They are also responsible for planning and co-ordinating education and training courses and administrating regional programmes and events.

Netball Development Officers (NDOs) work closely with the netballers and partners in the County to develop and deliver a local plan for netball. They focus on: developing netball for children and young people; helping clubs gain CAPS accreditation; organising back to netball groups and festivals; and promoting and organising suitable development opportunities for coaches, officials and volunteers. They also contribute to the planning and organisation of regional events.



Netball Development Community Coaches (NDCCs) are responsible for developing, marketing and coaching the Back to Netball and Walking Netball programmes. They are also responsible for developing local netball infrastructures to ensure sustained participation in the sport.
