The International Junior Netball Tournament

The Tournament will undoubtedly be the highlight of the Festival and has been organised to be suitable for a range of junior age groups and abilities. Your teams will play in either the **Showdown Tournament** or **Challenger Tournament** at each age group, ensuring teams are closely matched and to provide a competitive, safe and enjoyable experience for all involved.

Working with the direct support and input of England Netball, we will liaise with you to ensure your teams are entered into the appropriate tournament. The Showdown Tournament is for the stronger teams, that play more regularly in tournaments and leagues. The Challenger Tournament is therefore for teams that play less regularly, but who still wish to play in a competitive tournament.

Furthermore, as a professionally organised tournament, the International Junior Netball Tournament will allow young players to enjoy and benefit from their matches being officiated by England Netball qualified umpires.

Every team will play Tournament matches on Days Two and Four of the Five-Day Festival.

On Day Two, teams will participate in the Pool matches of either the Showdown Tournament or the Challenger Tournament, which will then determine the teams' participation in either the International Cup, Shield, Plate or Bowl Competition of their Tournament on Day Four. The Play-Offs and Finals in each age group will then be played on Day Four.

Our Festival courts are all indoors and have been reserved for our exclusive use for the duration of the Festival.

The Tournament is open to all school and club teams at Under 12, Under 14 and Under 16 age groups. Please note that the Tournament is only open to girls teams.

All matches are played in accordance with age-group laws. A full copy of the Tournament rules will be distributed to all teams prior to the Festival.

Tournament Awards Dinner

On the final evening of the Festival, we host the Awards Ceremony in Disney Village®, with complimentary dinner included for all players, coaches, teachers and official supporters.

The international and Superleague players will attend the dinner, that is sure to be highly enjoyable for both the young players and accompanying adults. The international and Superleague players will then present the tournament winners with their trophies, as well as making a number of individual player awards.

The Festival itinerary reflects our appreciation of the importance of ensuring you enjoy the right balance of time playing sport and at leisure during your time away.

Day One

You have the choice of being collected by Sport Experiences' coach from your school or club this morning, with all your travel arrangements organised and managed by Sport Experiences, or of making your own way to Disneyland® Paris. If you choose our travel-inclusive package, our coach will collect you from your school or club in the morning and take you to Dover or Folkestone for your Channel crossing to Calais. The journey from Calais to Disneyland® Paris takes approximately five hours.

On arrival, our Festival managers will check you into your accommodation and you will then have the remainder of the evening free to settle in. During the evening, we will host the Group Leaders Welcome Meeting to ensure you are fully prepared for the Festival.

Day Two

This morning we will commence the International Junior Netball Tournament matches, which will take place throughout the morning and early afternoon. At this pool stage of the Tournament, teams compete to determine their place in either The International Cup or Shield Competition Play-Offs and

Finals. All games are played in accordance with age-group laws and are officiated by qualified England Netball umpires.

The remainder of the afternoon and early evening are then free to enjoy Disneyland® Park and Walt Disney Studios® Park. All attendees of the International Junior Netball Festival receive a three-day Hopper Ticket, that will provide them with unlimited access on Days Two, Three and Four to both Disneyland® Park and Walt Disney Studios® Park. Therefore outside of the time devoted to netball, everyone is free to enjoy both Disney® Parks, ensuring a packed itinerary.

Day Three

Today players and coaches will take part in our exclusive Coaching Clinics and Masterclasses, delivered by England Netball's team of experienced coaches and Superleague and international players.

Many of the coaches have been involved in netball as players from a young age, so there are no better people to learn from and to guide your team in what it takes to perform to the best of their ability, both as individuals and collectively.

By spending time with each team and players individually it is possible to deliver bespoke and innovative sessions that build on their current ability levels and lay the foundations for future development.

There will then be free time during the late afternoon and early evening to enjoy the Disney® Parks. Once again, today everyone will be able to use their Hopper Ticket, providing you with unlimited access to both Disneyland® Park and Walt Disney Studios® Park.

Day Four

The International Cup and Shield Competition Play-Offs and Finals will be played today, taking place during the morning and early afternoon. Sure to be competitive and featuring a high standard of netball, they also enable players to put into practise the knowledge and skills picked up during the Coaching Clinics and Masterclasses. The Superleague and international players will rejoin us at the courts to support the teams in their Finals matches.

The remainder of the afternoon after the Play-Offs and Finals is then free for you to enjoy the Disney® Parks. Once again, your Hopper Ticket will provide you with unlimited access to both Disneyland® Park and Walt Disney Studios® Park.

The Festival will conclude with the Awards Ceremony, held in Disney Village®, with dinner included. The international and Superleague players will present the tournament winners with their trophies.

After breakfast you will leave Disneyland® Paris and make the journey back to your school or club, either with Sport Experiences' coach or making your own travel arrangements.



Coaching Clinics & Masterclasses



The International Junior Netball Festival Coaching Clinics and Masterclasses have been created to improve both the skills of individual players and team development. These clinics will be led by full time England Netball coaches who are involved at the game at the highest level.

We will also be joined by International and Superleague players who will spend time with teams during the clinics and masterclasses to offer advice, answer positional specific questions and inspire our young netballers to play to the best of their ability.

The aims of the clinics and masterclasses are to develop individual and team skills by offering bespoke coaching sessions on all aspects of the game including attack, defence, ball handling and shooting. This coaching delivery, combined with the knowledge and enthusiasm of England Netball's top level coaches and the international and Superleague players, creates the perfect environment to encourage positive game play and promote player progression.

The team of coaches and elite players understand the importance of delivering fun and enjoyable coaching sessions. Therefore we guarantee these clinics and masterclasses to be interactive and engaging for players of all ability levels.

In the last three years, we have been joined by International and Superleague stars, including **Joline Henry, Chioma Matthews, Josie Danz-Dawson, Sasha Corbin, Ama Agbeze, Mikki Austin, Rachel Dunn, Stacey Francis, Lindsay Keable, Sophia Candappa and Natalie Haythornthwaite.**

The coaching programme will begin with a fun and innovative warm up before teams take to the court for their coaching clinics and masterclasses. The warm up will provide players and coaches with new and fun ideas whilst also incorporating the 'Disney Spirit'.

No two sessions will be the same, as they are all tailored to your teams' requirements; whether you are a club who competes weekly or a school taking part in your first festival.



In addition to the coaching clinics and masterclasses, teams will also take part in the **'Disney Netball Skills Challenge'**. This offers the chance for players to compete in a series of fun netball challenges, where they will compete against their teammates and utilise some of the skills learnt within the coaching clinics and masterclasses.

As well as the on court benefits provided to young players by working with highly experienced coaches and international and Superleague players, the coaching clinics and masterclasses are also delivered to boost confidence and self-belief.

We also invite teachers and team coaches to observe the clinics and masterclasses, so that the England Netball coaching team can provide you with new ideas and develop your coaching skills.

You therefore have the assurance and peace of mind of knowing that the expert team with whom you liaise and work with when organising and making your booking is the same team that will host you and your tour party at the Festival.

Five Day Travel-inclusive Festival Arrangements

We are pleased to offer all groups of 40 or more paying passengers the exclusive use of their own 48 or 49-seater coach for the journey to and from the Festival at no extra cost. Groups of less than 40 paying passengers may be allocated a shared coach with another school or club for the duration of the Festival. Alternatively, groups of less than 40 paying passengers can pay a supplement to have sole use of their coach for the five days of the Festival.

On Days Two, Three and Four, you will need to travel between your accommodation, the Disney® Parks and the netball courts. A number of Sport Experiences' coaches will provide all these transfers for groups booking our five day travel-inclusive Festival package.

Group Size

The International Junior Netball Festival is available for all schools and clubs. The minimum group size is 10 passengers, including both players and accompanying passengers. Your Accommodation – Disney's Davy Crockett Ranch

Specifically chosen for its suitability for junior sports teams, Disney's Davy Crockett Ranch offers cabin-style accommodation. The bungalow cabins all have two bedrooms, two bathrooms, a kitchen equipped with electric hob and microwave oven and living/dining room with colour television and telephone.

The two-bedroom cabins all have one double bed in one bedroom and three or four single beds in the second bedroom.

It is therefore possible to accommodate up to six people in a cabin. However due to French legislation, please note that it is only permitted for adults to share the double bed.

Breakfast is provided each morning, which you eat in your cabin. For dinner, you are welcome to select from the restaurants in Disney Village®, pre-book meals at Disney's Davy Crockett Ranch (please see page 8) or self cater in your Ranch cabins.

Ideal for groups, the Ranch's large indoor swimming pool is available for use by guests, free of charge.

The Ranch Tavern and the swimming pool will be closed for refurbishment during the Easter 2018 Festival.



Festival Support Information

Meals

The International Junior Netball Festival includes continental breakfasts every morning at Disneyland® Paris, served at your accommodation. For lunch, we offer the opportunity to pre-order packed lunches, full details of which will be sent to you prior to the Festival.

On Day One, Day Two and Day Three evenings, groups can choose to pre-book evening meals at Disney's Davy Crockett Ranch or self cater, by purchasing food at a supermarket and then using their Ranch cabins' electric hob and microwave.

Alternatively, on Day One groups can stop en-route to Disneyland® Paris at a motorway services to have dinner. When in the Disney® Parks or Disney Village®, there is a wide variety of food outlets and restaurants available, including McDonalds.

Pre-bookable Ranch Cabin Evening Meals

These evening meals are delivered to your cabins during the afternoon and will need to be heated using the microwave oven in each cabin and then be eaten in your cabins.

Menu 1) Spaghetti Bolognese, Piedmont-style salad, fruit, Magnum ice cream, 50cl bottle of Coca Cola or water – price £18.00 per person.

Menu 2) Cheeseburger, French fries, apple compote, Magnum ice cream, 50cl bottle of Coca Cola or water – price £18.00 per person.

Menu 3) Ham & Cheese Pizza, grated carrot salad, almond soft cake, apple compote, 50cl bottle of Coca Cola or water – price £18.00 per person.

Please note: Menu 3 also available with vegetarian pizza.

Pre-bookable Ranch Tavern Restaurant

Evening Meals (October 2018 & Easter 2019).

The Ranch Restaurant serves an 'All you can eat buffet', including soft drinks. Vegetarian options are available. You will need to select a reservation time, between 1800hrs and 2200hrs, which will be reconfirmed to you prior to travel. Price £38.00 per adult, £25.00 per player/child (aged 3-16).

For October 2018 and Easter 2019, we offer the Sport Experiences Meal Plan, providing you with breakfast, lunch and dinner options for £126 per person. Contact us for details of what is included. Please indicate on the Booking Form if you wish to pre-book any evening meals at the Ranch. For the Easter 2018 Festival, the Tavern restaurant will be closed for refurbishment.

Complimentary Awards Ceremony Dinner

On the final evening of your stay, Sport Experiences arranges a complimentary dinner for all the teams at one of the Disney Village®'s restaurants, where we host our Awards Ceremony and Presentations.

Superleague and International Players

Please note that due to the nature and significance of the day to day responsibilities of the Superleague and international players, it occasionally becomes impossible for them to attend as planned. Should this occur, we will of course arrange for other players to attend.

Netball Courts

Please note that the courts used are hired from local sports centres.

Festival Schedule

In the event of the expected high demand for the Festival, we will also need to schedule fixtures during the afternoon and evening. In the event of this, teams would then have the morning and early afternoon free to enjoy the Disney® Parks. You will be notified of your netball matches and coaching clinics and masterclass times with your travel documentation.

Exclusive use of your Coach for groups of less than 40 paying passengers

We appreciate that some schools and clubs may wish to have exclusive use of their coach, however are unable to arrange a group of 40 or more paying passengers. We are able to provide these smaller groups with exclusive use of their own coach for a supplement related to their group size:

35 – 39 paying passengers £500

30 – 34 paying passengers £1000

25 – 29 paying passengers £1400

20 – 24 paying passengers £1900

For groups of less than 20 paying passengers we cannot offer exclusive use of the coach.

Kit Preparation & Laundry Facilities

It is not possible to provide laundry facilities.

We therefore recommend that teams bring two playing strips, one for Day Two and one for Day Four. On Day Three, teams should wear training kit for the coaching sessions.

24 Hour Emergency Support

Sport Experiences operates a 24-hour emergency paging system to provide complete security and peace of mind throughout your trip. Most problems can be dealt with quite satisfactorily by our local representatives and Disneyland® Paris staff but it is reassuring to know that our Operations Department is there to provide a friendly and professional service at whatever time of the day or night you might need them.

Your Financial Peace of Mind

In line with the EC Directive on package travel, all customers enjoy complete financial protection through our ABTA bond, so all payments are safe.

Passports and Visas

Group leaders are entirely responsible for ensuring that all members of the group have the correct and valid documentation. We cannot accept responsibility for any failure to comply resulting in any costs or fines being incurred.

Disneyland® Paris Accommodation Damage Policy

The International Junior Netball Festival is intended to be an enjoyable event for everyone involved. We would like to emphasise the importance of your group being properly briefed prior to the event and re-emphasise the importance of your role as Group Leader in supervising your group during your stay at Disneyland® Paris.

On your day of departure all cabins occupied by your group will be inspected for damage. Any damage found in the cabins will be charged for and any payment due will need to be settled before your group is allowed to leave (unless the damage was reported by the Group Leader upon arrival). Further details, including a price list with examples of the costs incurred in replacing damaged items, are available on request and will be given to you on arrival.

Disney's Davy Crockett Ranch

The Ranch is located around 10 minutes drive from the Disney® Parks. For groups choosing to self-drive, there is a private parking space for each cabin at Disney's Davy Crockett Ranch, as well as coach parking facilities. Please note that, based on French legislation regarding children, only cabins including adult family members can have more than five guests sharing a cabin. Please also note that the swimming pool is subject to seasonal closures, however once these dates are known, we will inform you in the unlikely event that it coincides with the Festival.

Should any members of your tour party wish to have sole occupancy of a cabin, then a supplement of £300 will be payable, in addition to the 2 sharing price.

In certain circumstances we reserve the right to transfer bookings to Disney's Hotel Cheyenne at Disneyland® Paris or the Kyriad Hotel at Disneyland® Paris or the B&B Hotel at Disneyland® Paris. Should this change be necessary, you will be advised prior to the preparation of your travel documentation.

Disneyland® Paris

Please note that certain shows, attractions, lands in Disneyland® Park and Walt Disney Studios® Park, entertainment, shops and restaurants may be closed, modified, delayed or cancelled without prior notice.

Guest Conduct

The Disneyland® Paris security department requires that each group leader signs a declaration of 'Responsibility and Accountability' form for their group. By signing the Booking Form, you confirm your acceptance of the booking conditions on conduct.

YOUR CONTRACT WITH US

1 YOUR BOOKING

Your booking, represents a contract between all persons named on the Booking, and/or on the Personal Details booking page, and/or on the Confirmation of Reservation, and Newmarket Holidays (The Company). The contract is based on the information given in the brochure and the terms laid out in the following Booking Conditions. This agreement is governed by English Law and jurisdiction is conferred on the Courts of England and Wales only unless, in the case of Court proceedings, you live in Scotland or Northern Ireland. In this case, proceedings must either be brought in the Courts of your home country or those of England and Wales. If proceedings are brought in Scotland or Northern Ireland, you may choose to have your contract and claim governed by the law of Scotland/Northern Ireland as applicable (but if you do not so choose, English law will apply). We do not accept bookings from any unaccompanied passengers under the age of 18.

2 YOUR PAYMENT

Your Confirmation of Reservation includes an invoice showing the deposit paid and the final balance due. The outstanding amount must be paid by the due date. Should we not receive payment by this date we reserve the right to treat your booking as cancelled, in which case you could be liable to pay cancellation charges according to the scale set out in paragraph 4 below. N.B. 1: The person making the on-line booking does so on behalf of all persons named on it, and he/she becomes directly responsible to the Company for the payment of the total holiday price and if applicable, and where appropriate, for the cancellation charges and disbursements of any funds.

3 YOUR ALTERATIONS

If you want to change any of the details of your booking, we will always do our best to help. We will however make an amendment charge of £10 per person (maximum £40 per Personal Details booking page per amendment) as a contribution to our administrative expenses. If after the final balance has become due you wish to make an alteration, we reserve the right to make cancellation charges as detailed in paragraph 4 below. All amendments must be notified to us in writing, by telephone or by e-mail, by the person who made the original booking. N.B. 2: If an amendment involves a change of name, insurance premiums are not transferable. Where any change is made to a booking involving travel by air and/or rail, we reserve the right to make additional charges to cover in full any costs charged to us by our suppliers.

4 YOUR CANCELLATION

You may cancel your booking or part of it once it has been confirmed but the cancellation will only be valid if made in writing direct to the Company or by telephone to our Customer Service team and having answered the security questions. If the cancellation results in a person travelling alone, a single room supplement is payable. The amount payable on cancellation depends upon when we receive your written instructions - the more notice you give, the less we will charge. The different periods before departure date within which written instructions are received by Newmarket Holidays Ltd and the amounts of cancellation charge (shown as a percentage of the total holiday price excluding insurance premium which is not refundable) are as follows:

5 YOUR COMPLAINTS

In the unlikely event that you have problems whilst on holiday, you MUST report the matter to the hotel or our representative IMMEDIATELY during your holiday. If the matter is not then satisfactorily resolved, you must complete a written report (form available from our representative). You must then follow up any complaint in writing within fourteen days of your return, including a copy of the original report form. We operate a strict code of conduct which also conforms to European regulations on package travel and take any complaints received seriously. A failure to follow the procedure outlined will affect the outcome of the complaint and any possible compensation.

6 YOUR TRAVELLING CONDITIONS

Where as part of the holiday you have booked your travel by air, land or sea, such travel will be subject to the terms and conditions of carriage of the airline, shipping, rail or coach company providing the transport. In most cases, the conditions will limit the carrier's liability to you in accordance with international law. Should anyone be refused admission to the coach, ferry or flight, or to the destination country by the transport or government authority, then we are powerless to assist and cannot be held responsible. This includes any passenger who fails to advise us of any medical condition or disability. If you are prevented from travelling as a result, our responsibility for your holiday thereupon ceases. Full cancellation charges will apply and we will be under no obligation whatsoever for any refund, compensation or loss you may incur.

OUR CONTRACT WITH YOU

1 OUR CONFIRMATION OF RESERVATION

When we have received your booking and deposit we will send you a Confirmation of Reservation which details exactly what is booked for you. From this moment Newmarket Holidays has accepted your booking on the terms set out in this Contract.

2 THE PRICE OF YOUR HOLIDAY

Changes in transportation costs, including the cost of fuel, duties, taxes or fees chargeable for services and exchange rates, mean that the price of your travel arrangements may change after you have booked. However there will be no change within 30 days of your departure. We will absorb and you will not be charged for any increase equivalent to 2% of the price of your travel arrangements, which excludes insurance premiums and any amendment charges. You will be charged for the amount over and above that. If this means that you have to pay an increase of more than 10% of the price of your travel arrangements, you will have the option of accepting a change to another holiday if we are able to offer one (if this is of equivalent or higher quality you will not have to pay more but if it is of lower quality you will be refunded the difference in price), or cancelling and receiving a full refund of all monies paid, except for any amendment charges. Should the price of your holiday go down due to the changes mentioned above, by more than 2% of your holiday cost, then any refund due will be paid to you. However, please note that travel arrangements are not always purchased in local currency and some apparent changes have no impact on the price of your travel due to contractual and other protection in place. The costs of your holiday have been converted into GBP using these exchange rates: EUR 1.1750; USD 1.3048; CAD 1.6901; NOK 10.9487.

SYSTEM ERRORS

We try hard to ensure that advertised prices are up to date, and reflect the price you will pay when you book. However, prices can change and errors can occasionally occur. We reserve the right to change and correct advertised prices at any time before your booking is confirmed.

In the event of your Confirmation of Reservation showing an incorrect price for your holiday, the price that will prevail is the price shown in our offline reservation system. Accordingly you may not seek to rely on system errors with a view to obtaining a holiday at less than the correct price, and any contract entered into upon a mistake, such as a wrong costing due to system errors, is not valid or binding.

3 OUR ALTERATIONS

It is unlikely that we will have to make any changes to your holiday but we do plan your holiday arrangements many months in advance. Occasionally changes may be made, which we reserve the right to do at any time. Most of these changes are minor (eg. cancellation of an optional excursion) and we will advise you at the earliest possible date. A major change is one that we make to your holiday arrangements before departure that involves, for example, changing your resort area, or time of departure or return by more than twelve hours, or offering accommodation with a lower official classification than that advertised (except the latter in the case of en route tour hotels). If a major change becomes necessary we will inform you as soon as is reasonably possible if there is time before your departure. When a major change occurs you will have the choice of either accepting the change of arrangements, purchasing another available holiday from us (we will refund any price difference if alternative is of lower value), or cancelling your holiday and receiving a full refund of all monies paid. When a major change occurs, provided it does not arise from circumstances amounting to force majeure (see below), we will pay compensation as detailed below, based on how far ahead of departure the change is advised:

4 OUR CANCELLATIONS

We reserve the right in any circumstances (including failure to reach sufficient numbers) to cancel your holiday and in this event we will return to you all money you have paid to us or will offer you an alternative, available holiday to purchase of comparable standard. In no case, except for reasons of war etc, (see N.B. 4 above) will your holiday be cancelled after the date when your final balance becomes due.

OUR RESPONSIBILITY FOR YOUR HOLIDAY

1 OVERSEAS HOLIDAYS

(a) Although we have no direct control over services provided to you by independent suppliers we accept responsibility for the reasonable standard of the holiday which you book. If any part is not provided as promised, we will pay you appropriate compensation if this has affected the enjoyment of your holiday, except where the failure is unforeseeable or unavoidable. We can normally agree an amicable settlement of the few complaints we receive. However, if we cannot agree, disputes arising out of, or in connection with this Contract may (if the customer so wishes) be referred to arbitration under a special Scheme which, though devised by arrangement with the Association of British Travel

Agents, is administered independently by the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators. The Scheme (details of which will be supplied on request) provides for a simple and inexpensive method of arbitration on documents alone with restricted liability on the customer in respect of costs. The Scheme does not apply to claims for an amount greater than £5,000 per person. There is also a limit of £25,000 per booking. Neither does it apply to claims which are solely or mainly in respect of physical injury or illness or the consequences of such injury or illness. Redress under this Scheme requires written notice requesting arbitration to be made within nine months of scheduled date of return from the holiday.

- (b) We accept responsibility if you or any person named on the booking suffers bodily injury, illness or death due to the negligent acts and/or omissions of: (i) our employees or agents; or (ii) our suppliers or sub-contractors, servants or agents whilst acting within the scope or in the course of their employment to provide any service or arrangement forming part of the holiday that you have booked with us save that we do not accept responsibility for any air or sea carriers whose liabilities are limited by the relevant International Conventions.
